I want to thank you for your interest in the St. Johns Community as well as St. Johns Public School District. We have compiled several pieces of information that should give you a flavor regarding our school district.

St. Johns School District covers approximately 240 square miles. We have four rural elementary schools as well as two city elementary schools. We are a class "A" high school, and have a middle school along with a community education program that houses our alternative education program. In 1995 our community passed a 42.5 million dollar bond. This bond also allowed us to build two elementary school buildings within the city limits, and a middle school. We have also done extensive renovations and additions to all buildings in the district. Further we have spent over our technology program. We have our school district, along with 176 support staff members and employees. Our operating dollars a year and our 2006-2007 per pupil foundation grant is \$7,085.
