

**SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER BLADES, ETC.  
ORDINANCE NO. 488**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 415, AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER BLADES, ROLLER SKATES AND OTHER COASTER-WHEELED DEVICES ON CERTAIN STREETS AND SIDEWALKS FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF ST JOHNS.

THE CITY OF ST JOHNS ORDAINS:

**Section 1.** Section 3 of Ordinance No. 415 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 3. Coaster-wheeled devices prohibited.**

The use of the coaster-wheeled devices defined herein is hereby prohibited in the City of St. Johns on the following designated streets, sidewalks and parking areas:

- A Clinton Avenue between State Street (M-21) and Railroad Street and adjacent sidewalks and parking areas thereto, and;
- B State Street (M-21), Walker, Higham and Railroad Streets between Spring and Brush Streets, and adjacent sidewalks and parking areas thereto, and;
- C Maple Street and Linden Street between Cass Street and State Street (M-21) and adjacent sidewalks and parking areas thereto, and;
- D All municipally owned parking facilities and exterior sidewalks, stairs and ramps within the City of St Johns owned by or located upon property owned by the City of St Johns and /or County of Clinton.

**Section 2.** All other provisions of Ordinance No. 415 remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect twenty days after its passage.
